THE GOOD LIFE

The newly unveiled Pendry Residences West Hollywood by Montage Hotels & Resorts redefines luxury living.

One step inside the Pendry Residences West Hollywood and you'll never want to leave. Designed by Ehrlich Yanai Rhee Chaney Architects and Martin Brudnizki Design Studio, the collection of 40 residences—which average 2,900 square feet, with select models up to 6,000 square feet—was designed and treated as a custom-build home project—and it shows.

Steeped in opulence from the inside out, the design concept is a beautiful marriage of local and global elements, taking cues from the quintessential indoor-outdoor California living experience and from international architectural aspects such as the Italian piazza and Moroccan courtyards and rooftop verandas. "The design manages to achieve privacy and density while simultaneously taking advantage of the steep, sloping site and re-creating a new urban 'hill town,'" says Mathew Chaney, EYRC Architects partner in charge on the project.

Blurring the line between indoor and outdoor living, each home opens onto an expansive terrace or balcony boasting prime city vistas. For those wanting more privacy and exclusivity, a few select units feature private rooftop gardens with a private pool, spa, fire pit and outdoor kitchen for the ultimate alfresco living experience.

Inside the unabashedly contemporary residences, an open floor plan concept creates a unified living space by combining the great room and the Martin Brudnizki custom-designed kitchen, which features high-end appliances from Sub-Zero and Wolf and complementing design elements including rift-sawn white oak custom stained cabinets, Waterworks fixtures and oversize Calacatta Borghini marble islands. Venture farther and you're continually met with lavish, elevated elements, especially in the master bathroom, revealing a handselected honed Arabescato Cervaiole marble finish, deep soaking tubs, custom double vanities, bespoke millwork and modern nickel light fixtures by Waterworks.

To cap off what can only be described as the dream abode, residents gain access to resident-exclusive services and amenities, including their own rooftop, pool, lobby, owners lounge and private elevator access into their home. All of the perks of five-star hotel living combined with the luxury and seclusion of a custom-built home—it doesn't get any better than that. From \$3 million, pendryresidencesweho.com
